Summary of 2018 Surveys

Passport Survey Results/trends

Total of 113 Passport Surveys were completed on the day.

Community Connections

Bathurst Family Fun day made me feel welcomed and respected was the overall response from the survey achieving 83/113, followed by 71/113 people agreed that Bathurst Family Fun day helped them find out about services or information to help me or my family. Overall a very positive response on all other community connections questions, no one disagreed.

What other places do you go with your children

Going to the park or playground was the most popular choice amongst those doing the survey, as it was the highest score in other places to go with your children on a weekly and fortnightly basis, leaving attending concerts and plays being the highest for going to on a monthly/yearly basis

How you feel about Bathurst Family Fun Day

Those doing the survey had a really positive response to the overall day, 97 (Strongly agree) 16 (agree) I am happy with the Family Fun day for me and my family and 99 (strongly agree) 11 (agree) that they would recommend Family Fun day to a friend.

What did you like most about the Event?

The common trend among all those doing the survey that what they liked most about the event, was that it was free, they had great activities and entertainment everyone especially for kids, staff and everyone was really friendly, it was a lot of fun and great day.

How could we improve?

Overall from those that attended the common idea for improvements, were to have it more than once a year, maybe when its warmer as well, as it was so great. To have activities and options for teens ages 10-15 years, to have more stalls and to advertise more leading up to the event, in schools and radio for example. In the survey only 12/113 (Schools) 10/113 (Newspaper) 13/113 (Radio). Most people seen in on Facebook, leaving opportunity for other ways to advertise as well.

2018 Bathurst Family Fun Day

Feedback showed that an additional 43 people attended this year that had never been before and had 53 people return that had been to a previous event in the past years. Family Fun day seems to be what people recognise mostly with what The Bathurst Child and Family Network is about as 74/113 was the highest overall score.

BCFN Circles Results/trends 2017+2018

Purpose: The Bathurst Child and Family Network (BCFN) want to know what you think about children because we're working to make Bathurst more child-friendly for the benefit of all children, young people and families.

Question *'I feel that my children are valued and included in the Bathurst community'*

2018 results below:

- Circle 1 (agree) = 78% - This has been a huge increase on last year by 49.2%
- Circle 2 (mostly agree) = 11% - This has dropped by 3.9%
- Circle 3 (somewhat agree) = 9% - Increased by 7.51%
- Circle 4 (somewhat disagree) = 2% - This has dropped by 5.45
- Circle 5 (disagree) = 0% - This has dropped by 8.9%
- Beyond the circles (strongly disagree) = 0% - This has dropped by 2.9%

Overall compared to last year, there has been an increase, results show 98% of those that attended Bathurst Family Fun day said they either somewhat, mostly or just agreed that they feel their children are valued in the Bathurst Community. Leaving only 2% to disagree. There were less people to respond to this survey this year (45) compared to last years (67).
